Mountain Tap Brewery in Steamboat Springs, CO is looking for a motivated intern to
learn and assist with brewery related tasks, details below!**

This is a PAID internship with opportunity for longer-term employment!

The ideal candidate will either be enrolled in or have recently completed a formal brewery education program *OR* have relevant brewery experience.

Mountain Tap Brewery's busy season is June – September. We can use a little extra help during these months (and possibly beyond) and you can learn a lot about everything brewery related from brewing, cellarwork, packaging, QA, safety, etc.

Start date May/June, end date TBD.

Requirements:

- Prior relevant brewery experience a plus!
- Formal brewing education & some canning experience preferred.
- Self-starter, ability to take initiative, manage time efficiently and work independently.
- Exceptional focus, organizational skills, meticulous attention to details with beer quality, sanitation and safety.
- Excellent interpersonal skills - must be team player.
- Must be able to lift 55 lbs (bags of grain), hand truck kegs, spent grain tubs and regularly bend, twist, reach, stoop and climb ladders periodically.
- Must be able to work early mornings (most brewery work is M-F between ~6:00 AM – 2:00 PM, occasional weekends).
- Must be 21+ years old and have a passion for craft beer and mountain lifestyle.

Responsibilities – Brewery Operations (below is not all-inclusive)

- Cellarwork – CIP'ing tanks & equipment. Transferring beer from fermentation to serving tanks and carbonating.
- Kegging – keg cleaning, sanitizing, filling & keg machine maintenance (Premier 2-head semi-automatic).
- Draft system – cleaning & maintaining draft lines and dispense equipment.
- QA – Use & maintenance of DO meter & CO2 testing equipment.
- Safety – Must work in a safe manner, wear proper PPE as appropriate, maintain a clean, tidy and organized workplace at all times and adhere to safety procedures.
- Assist with brewing – For example grain handling/milling, yeast handling, dry-hopping, etc. (7 bbl Premier brewhouse, 15 bbl unitanks, 7 bbl serving tanks)
- Assist with canning operations (~2-3x/month).
- Assist with maintenance – brewery & pub cleaning/maintenance projects.
- Assist with managing inventories, raw materials, CIP chems and other brewery supplies as necessary.
- Work with brewing team/owners collaborating specialty beer projects.
- Assist with events and promotions as necessary (occasionally).

Compensation:

\$21 - \$25/ hr

Complimentary shift meal and shift beer (for legal drinking age employees).

Food, beer, merchandise discounts and other employee benefits.

Mountain Tap Brewery uniform.

Additional benefits such as house account, wellness stipend and opportunity to participate in SIMPLE IRA dependent upon transition to a permanent position.
